

INSTRUCTIONS: How to Use the Letter of Authorization

The Letter of Authorization is required in case you have someone retrieve lost/found property from the police (A family member living with you does not need to be authorized in writing to pick up property except when claiming mobile phones).

Receipt of Found Property or Notification of Found Property (if not available, advise the clerk of the name of the appropriate police station, date reported and report number)(3) the clerk of the name of the appropriate police station, date reported and report number(4) Notification of Found Mobile Phone from your mobile phone carrier (if not available, advise the clerk of the name of the appropriate police station, date reported, report number and SIM card number or serial number) |
